DID YOU KNOW?

Each year, FFA chapters around the country celebrate National FFA Week. The week-long tradition began in 1947 when the National FFA Board of Directors designated the week of George Washington's birthday as National FFA Week in recognition of his legacy as an agriculturist and farmer. The first National FFA Week was held in 1948. Today, FFA Week always runs Saturday to Saturday and encompasses Feb. 22, Washington's birthday.

National FFA Week did not start out

as a week-long event. At first it was National FFA Day. The 1933 National FFA Convention Proceedings records the beginning of FFA Day in this way: "Stewart of Montana requested the floor at this time to present a matter of general interest. He suggested the idea of having a special Future Farmer Day some time during 1934, preferably on one of the regular national FFA broadcasting days. It was pointed out that the various state associations could perhaps plan special state broadcasts also on that day and that chapters might plan their father and son banquets on the date specified. The idea

seemed to meet with general delegate approval and after some discussion it was moved by Stewart that the Board of Trustees arrange for such a day; motion passed."

I also help customers design customized planters, fulfill special orders, checkout customers, and help with the daily maintenance of the plants. After graduating high school, I plan to attend college and major in Biochemistry and further my education with a doctorate degree. I would like to work on the research side of the diversified industry of the genetics of crops.

My name is Emily Peterson. I am a senior at Cameron high school where I am also an active member of the Cameron FFA Chapter. I have served as a chapter historian, sentinel, and am currently serving as the chapter reporter. I live with my mom, Kari, my step dad, Justin, and my two younger siblings. My Ag Sales Placement SAE is working at our local Cameron Market. Throughout high school I have been on the Knowledge Team, state qualifier for Entomology Team and Livestock Judging Team, and this year I plan to be on the Floriculture Team.

My name is Abigail Robinson. I am a Junior at Cameron High School where I am the Secretary and an active member of the Cameron FFA Chapter. In Ag Communications I write, record and produce the local market report for our local Cameron radio, KKWK 100.1. I gather crop information from the Cameron Cooperative to produce the market report weekly on Thursdays. Each report takes about 15-30 total to complete.

Like most students in Ag Communications, I began as the Chapter Creed Speaker. However, my SAE has moved beyond just speech writing and delivery. During my freshman year I was given the opportunity to become

a paid writer for the Cameron Newspaper writing Ag related articles. I did the research, writing and editing for all of my articles. I also conducted interviews with the people whom I wrote about. Unfortunately, due to a change in editors, the newspaper decided that they did not want student writers and have since eliminated my position.

My next opportunity came the during the summer of 2016, the summer before my sophomore year. I was approached by the station and production managers of KKWK, our local Cameron Radio Station. They asked if I would be interested in doing a daily crop reports. I agree and began recording the reports in September. Everyday around 11:46 in the morning I got a text from the Cameron Cooperative with the current month's price for corn and soybeans as well as, October's corn and soybeans price. I used my phone to create a script and then record the reports on my phone. It takes me about thirty seconds to do the actual recording but then I edit the recording which

takes a couple minutes. The recording is then emailed to the production team at the radio station where they do more editing to prepare it for the radio. By the time the recording is final and put on air it takes 15-30 minutes to do the entire process. I was in contact with the radio station about getting a paid summer internship, but due to a change in management interns were no longer allowed.

My market reports were daily up until September 2017, when my schedule at school changed. Due to the schedule change the reports went from daily reports to weekly reports. I follow the same process as before, but I only record my market reports on Thursdays. Since Thursday is our long seminar hour my ag teacher allows me to record the report in her room during lunch when her classroom is empty.




My name is Andrew Neeley and I am a 9th grader. I do not have plans for an SAE project and am not on a contest team. When I get older I hope to join the military.



My name is Jared Groebe. I am a sophomore at Cameron High School where I am also and active member of the Cameron FFA chapter. I spend my time with my parents Dwayne and Ronda, living in the country on our blank acre farm. I have 2 older sisters that have already moved out. My SAE includes The blank portion of my SAE is working for my parents on the family farm.

CORN - Since 2014 I have worked for pay on our family farm in Osborn and the far edge of Cameron. I can run all of the farm equipment. I usually help buck tanks for anhydrous before planting season and then deliver seed to my dad in the field when he needs it. Before planting season we order the seed that we need. Then we get the planter ready for when the conditions are right. I help repair any parts of the planter that need to be repaired and I also grease the planter regularly. My mom usually is the one that works the crop ground each year while my dad plants and I do many miscellaneous stuff that needs to be done. We load the planter with the variety of seed we want to plant in the first field. My dad plants the field and then we have our local co-op spray all the chemicals necessary.

BEANS - Since 2014 I have worked for pay on our family farm in Osborn and the far edge of Cameron. I can run all of the farm equipment. We always order seed ahead of planting beans. I have a couple important jobs when it comes to planting season, I always help with dumping all the treated beans into the bulk gravity wagon. We can fill it up with all the same variety of beans or with two different

varieties. It usually takes an hour to fill our whole planter. When we are planting beans I am always on call for helping with filling the planter, any breakdowns, and bringing stuff to the field for my parents.

FORAGE- Since 2014 I have worked for pay on our family farm in Osborn and the far edge of Cameron. I can run all of the farm equipment. We start haying season by getting the mower conditioner, the V-rake, and the baler out and serviced and checked over to make sure everything is in good shape to run all season. When we hook up the tractors to the implements they usually stay hooked up all season. We usually bale 1,000 to 2,000 big round bales each year. This year we plan on baling 500 to 1,000 small square bales for use on our farm and then sell the extra for part of my SAE.

BEEF - Since 2014 I have worked for pay on our family farm in Osborn and the far edge of Cameron. I started this SAE by purchasing 5 bred heifers from my parents in December of 2015. The They calved in January and February of 2016. I sold the calves in November of 2016 and purchased 5 more bred heifers at the first of this year and they are calving in January and February. I got into this SAE because my parents run a cow-calf operation that consists of 180 well and able cows. We sell our calves at Lamoni livestock auctions in Lamoni, Iowa. We used to raise Circle A cattle for them and we have grown to know all the people there and we trust them.




